

**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CAMPING AND OTHER ACTIVITIES  
AT THE FAIRPLAY BEACH AND RESERVOIR**

1. Maximum stay is four (4) nights.
2. Camping with tents only is allowed. RV's are not permitted.
3. No motorized vehicles are allowed in the camping area. (Wheelchairs excepted)
4. There are only seven (7) campsites. Permits shall be issued on a first come first serve basis.
5. No campfires are allowed. No charcoal grills are allowed. Cooking may only be done on a gas-fueled camp stove or grill.
6. No washing of dishes, cooking utensils, clothing or other property is allowed in the reservoir or creek.
7. Each campsite shall be occupied by no more than two (2) tents and/or six (6) people.
8. No noise permitted after 9:00 PM. Except for flashlights, all lights out by 11:00 PM.
9. Small generators are permitted, but only between the hours of 9:00 AM and 9:00 PM.
10. All trash must be picked up and removed from campsite and deposited in the waste receptacles in the parking area. Dumping of household trash is prohibited.
11. All pets must be kept on a leash and under control at all times. All pet waste must be picked up and removed from the campsite.
12. Open alcohol containers and the consumption of alcohol are prohibited.
13. Issuance of a camping permit does not include fishing or gold panning. It is the responsibility of the person engaging in these activities to make sure that all licenses and permits are properly obtained. All fishing shall be done from the shore. Fishing by wading or use of a flotation device is prohibited.
14. The use of boats or other flotation devices is prohibited on the reservoir and creek.
15. No swimming or wading is permitted.
16. Destroying, damaging or defacing public property is prohibited.
17. Anyone that violates the rules and regulations stated above, or vandalizes any of the facilities in the recreation area, may be removed and possible legal action taken. Violators will be subject to fine and/or imprisonment. Anyone removed from the camping area will forfeit any and all fees paid.
