BRING YOUR UNWANTED ITEMS TO THE TOWN SHOP 1190 COUNTY RD 16 (Castello Avenue)

Summer is coming so it's time to clear the clutter and beautify Fairplay!

Town Clean-up takes place again this year as part of the Town's Beautification and Code Enforcement efforts. The Town will be accepting unwanted items at the Town Shop at 1190 County Road 16 (Castello Ave.) from 7:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. on Friday, May 31st, 7:30am—4:30pm on Saturday, June 1st, and 7:30am—3pm on Sunday, June 2nd. There will be Town Staff on hand to help you unload your vehicle. This great opportunity is free to all Town residents and businesses. **You will be asked to prove residency, so make sure you have your water bill and/or a form of ID showing your physical address with you when you bring your items to discard. Your home or business must be located inside the Town limits.** Residents who are physically unable to bring their items to the shop should contact **Vaughn Mead, Assistant Public Works Director, (719) 836-2445, by 5/24/19 to schedule a pick up.**

Construction Debris	Household Trash
Yard & Tree Material (<i>no soil/dirt/rocks</i>)	Junk Cars
Scrap Metal (<i>no vehicles or vehicle frames</i>)	Hazardous Materials
Propane/ Gas Cylinders (<i>valves removed</i>)	Wet paint cans
Refrigerators and Freezers— <i>these will be accepted without the refrigerant removed</i>	Used Oil
Tires – <i>Separated from the Rims (\$5.00 each)</i>	Animal or Human Waste
Dried Paint cans	Gasoline
Stoves/Ovens (<i>no Microwave Ovens</i>)	Televisions, Computers and other electronic waste**
Dishwashers	Batteries
Water Heaters, Furnaces and Wood Stoves	Equipment/Tractor Tires
	Mattresses (box springs are okay)

****The Summit County Resource Allocation Park (SCRAP) accepts electronic waste** from out-of-county residents for the following fees: CPUs, monitors, DVD & VCR players, etc.: \$ 9 each; TVs 25 inches & under: \$20 each; Large office printers & scanners: \$20 each and TVs over 26 inches and large loads of electronics are charged by weight: \$0.50/lb.
