



## TOWN CLEAN-UP – June 7 through 11, 2010

Summer is just around the corner, so it's time to clear the clutter and beautify Fairplay. Town Clean-Up takes place again this year as part of the Town's Beautification and Code Enforcement efforts.

Beginning June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010, residents within the town limits of Fairplay are encouraged to begin compiling junk and debris (below is a list of acceptable items). When all items have been gathered, residents are asked to place them on the curb, careful not to block any sidewalks or streets. Public Works will pick up these items between June 7<sup>th</sup> and June 11<sup>th</sup>. Due to the size of this project, Public Works will make one stop per house. Therefore, residents should wait to put their items on the street until *all* items have been gathered.

Residents who are physically unable to put the debris on the street should contact Jeff Goble, Public Works Director to arrange a special services pick-up. (719) 836-2622.
